A Forest Preserve District of Will County dog park permit is required. Dog park permit applications are available at ReconnectWithNature.org/FileManager/DogClassReg2010.pdf or by visiting one of the Forest Preserve's visitor facilities. Annual permits are \$25 per dog for County residents and \$50 per dog for non-residents. A \$10 discount will be given to registrants of the class if they purchase a dog park permit at the same time as enrollment.

A \$10 discount will be given to dogs verified as rescued from a shelter when registering for Puppy Classes and Beginner Dog Obedience. A rescued dog discount does not apply if a dog park permit discount has been given.

- Dog must have completed a beginner obedience class to enroll in the agility classes.
- Handlers under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult to participate.
