### **Getting a Dog Park Permit**

For the safety of dog park users and their dogs, an annual permit is needed for those wishing to use the dog parks. To obtain your permit, please complete this form and send it with payment to Sugar Creek Administration Center located at 17540 W. Laraway Road Joliet, IL 60433. Permits are valid from the date of issue until December 31, 2018. Permit fees are outlined below. If you are an active military member or veteran please include a copy of your military ID card or a copy of your driver's license if it includes your military information to receive the discount.

### **Annual Permit**

Resident: \$40 Non-Resident: \$80 (Beginning July 1, 2017 permits are reduced to half price.)

### **Additional Dogs**

Residents: \$20/dog Non-Residents: \$30/dog

Senior (65+)/Military/Veteran Discount: \$10 off per permit

Daily Passes: \$5/dog/day Duplicate Passes: \$5 (one per permit)

Illinois 60433.You will receive a permit and ID lanyard for use at any of the dog parks within 10 business days. The ID lanyard must be worn at all times while using the dog parks.

## Rules of the Dog Parks

- 1. Dog park permits are issued to adults 18 years or older only.
- 2. Entry into the dog park without the appropriate permit is an Ordinance violation and will result in a fine and removal from the park.
- 3. Permit holders are required to wear the ID lanyard when in the dog park. Failure to do so will result in a citation and removal from the park. Photo reproduction of passes will not be accepted. If a permit is purchased online, the receipt will act as your temporary permit until the pass and lanyard are received in the mail. The receipt becomes an invalid method of using the park after 10 days of issuance.
- 4. All dog park permits expire at the end of the calendar year (Dec. 31, 2018).
- 5. Permit holders may have no more than three dogs in the dog park at one time.
- 6. A dog must be at least 6 months of age to obtain a permit and visit the dog park.
- 7. All dogs present must be registered with the District with a current rabies tag number and expiration date.
- 8. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to notify the District with updated rabies tag number and expiration date information.
- 9. Dogs must display a current rabies tag while inside the dog park.
- 10. Permit holders who foster dogs must notify the District if the dog associated with their permit changes.
- 11. When visiting the dog park, the permit holder must be present with the dog.
- 12. No alcohol consumption is allowed while in the dog park.
- 13. Permit holders must clean up after their dogs in both the dog park and the preserve. This includes any waste as well as water bowls and dog toys.
- 14. Leave unhealthy dogs and those in heat at home.
- 15. Small dog treats for training purposes are permitted; please refrain from bringing other food or treat items to the dog park.
- 16. Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the dog park. Dogs in a preserve must be leashed if they are outside of the dog park area. Leashes in excess of 10 feet are not allowed.
- 17. Owners must remain with their dogs inside the fenced dog park and keep their dogs under control at all times.
- 18. You must remove your dog immediately from the dog park at the first sign of aggressive behavior. Dogs are not allowed to disturb, harass or interfere with wildlife or other visitors. Permits may be revoked after repeated incidences of aggressive behavior.



- 19. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult and not left unattended at the dog park.
- 20. Failure to abide by any of these rules may result in a citation and/or revocation of the dog park permit.
- 21. In an emergency, call 911.
- 22. For Police non-emergencies, call (815) 727-6191.

By signing below, I agree to abide by all of the rules listed here and as posted at the dog parks to ensure the safety of my dog and other users of the dog parks. I recognize that the use of the dog parks may entail certain risk, injury or loss to dogs and people and I assume full responsibility for any injuries, damages and expenses that I, my dog or other dogs accompanying me might sustain while using this facility or any person or dog might sustain as a result of my dog's actions. I agree not to hold the Forest Preserve District of Will County liable for any loss or damage to persons or property arising from my use of the facilities or engaging in the activity for which this permit is granted. I agree to defend and hold harmless the Forest Preserve District of Will County and any associated parties for any and all claims or actions brought by myself, my heirs, my guests, contractors or invitees as a result of the exercise of the rights granted under this permit. Rules/regulations references to "owner" include the person responsible for the dog while at the dog park, whether or not that person is the legal owner of the dog.
